

**AMEND TAKING ORDER (AS TO DEFECTS)  
LAND ADMINISTRATION ACT 1997**

I (*Insert Hon Ministers full name here*), Minister for Lands, hereby order, in accordance with Section 180 of the *Land Administration Act 1997*, that defects in the following Order of Taking registered in the Land Title Division are corrected as described.

Any part of the earlier order that is inconsistent with this order as amended / is void. No person is to be prejudiced in respect of any interest in the land or in any right arising from such an interest by reason of having done or omitted to do any act or thing or comply with any obligation in respect of the interest or right in consequence of or reliance on the earlier order.

No person has any right of action or claim against the Crown, the Minister for Lands or an acquiring authority for anything done in good faith under the order before it was amended.

A claim for compensation in respect to any reasonable costs incurred in relation to the taking, up to and including the date of taking, or for any damage to the land caused by entry, must be lodged with the acquiring authority within 60 days of registration of this order.
